Nominations of works celebrating the rich history of North Carolina are welcomed for the 2025 Awards Program of the North Carolina Society of Historians.

Entries will be accepted from **March 1 - June 30, 2025.**

Successful entries must meet the following criteria:

- An author does not have to live in North Carolina to enter.
- All entries must - within the entry itself - clearly identify it's connection to the history and/or heritage of North Carolina.
- Anyone can submit an entry for another individual or an organization for any of the above categories (self-entry is also welcome).
- Entries may be made in the following categories:
 - History Books
 - Journalism
 - Publishing
 - Multi-Media
 - Organizations
 - Museums
 - Outstanding History Teachers and/or Student Historians Doing Exceptional History Projects
 - Historian of the Year

Works selected for an award will be honored at a ceremony later this year, date and location to be determined. Additional information about each
